Dear Parents

Greetings to everyone as we officially but virtually begin our new academic session from today. Once we resume school, teachers will take a follow up on the work that is going home and will record the progress of the students.

We have started Virtual Classroom for the senior students of Classes 8th, 9th and 10th and the students are participating in these sessions with enthusiasm. We are making slow but consistent progress towards bridging the gap created by lockdown.

Let us make the best use of this period as we know that Adversity is also a time of Opportunity. Let us embrace the moment and soon the crisis will be behind us.

Looking forward to another year of creating milestones. I invoke the blessings of the Almighty at the start of the year that He may keep us safe and healthy!
