




PRE PRIMARY NURSERY, KG I, KG II



PRIMARY

Class 1 to 5

In the Primary years, the focus is on encouraging inquiry, exploration and on inculcating confidence in key learning skills like – reading, writing, listening, speaking, information technology capability, problem-solving, observation and measurement. Children are encouraged to speak and perform at assemblies, concerts, drama productions to gain confidence in their ability to communicate to a wider audience.

We recognize that children at this level are active, curious, experimental, imaginative and, above all, disconcertingly frank. Each child is an individual with his or her own unique abilities, interests, aspirations and expectations. Therefore, our curriculum in these classes is structured to encourage and motivate them to become self-confident, self-reliant and self-disciplined learners.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

Class 6 to 8

Our approaches to learning emphasize interdisciplinary instruction, exploration, practical application and cooperative learning. 
